Washington County Sheriff Joins HPD With Tip Management, Two-Way Communication App

The Washington County Sheriff's Office in Hagerstown, Maryland is the second agency in the region to roll out the See Something, Send Something app.

Hagerstown, MD, June 2, 2018 - The Washington County Sheriff Office has chosen to implement the See Something, Send Something app to supplement their crime fighting efforts. An excerpt from the agency's website says "Crime Prevention, by definition is taking some action to prevent or reduce the chances of criminal activity."



The smart device apps allows law enforcement to set up invisible geofence broadcast notifications that alert community member's smart devices with pertinent information. After receiving information or as part of proactive empowerment, app users can submit tips with pictures, videos or attachments.
